Glamour-pusses inhunt for hunks

CRADLE-snatcher Sadie Frost has sparked a huge rise in the number of older women wanting a trendy toyboy.

Sugar-mummies in their 40s are increasingly on the prowl for younger men.

And about one in 10 of the ageing glamour-pusses admit they hope to snare a toyboy.

The figure has risen by 20% in the past year with a staggering 280,000 now looking for younger male flesh.

That increase comes after actress Sadie, 41, split from husband Jude Law, 34, and started seeing a string of much younger blokes.

She has romanced guitarist Jackson Scott, then 25, Andy Jones, then 25, and T4 presenter Alex Zane, who was 27.

But her latest fella Kristian Marr is the youngest yet at a tender 23. Holby City's Patsy Kensit, 39, also turned back the clock when she was linked with rapper Killa Kela, 27 - real name Lee Potter.

And Demi Moore, 44, became a poster girl for the fad after tying the knot with Ashton Kutcher, 29.

But women are still not as bad as blokes, with 42% of those in their 40s and 50s after a younger model.

Almost a quarter of the sugar-daddies want to find a lover 10 years younger.

The survey revealed the trend for sugar-mummies is not just confined to the city - lusty country folk are the worst culprits.

Almost two-thirds of the pack are based in rural areas and do most of their prowling on internet sites.

But while women are after fun with a young guy, the men are more interested in food and comfort.

Psychiatrist Dr Victoria Lukats said: "A lovingly prepared home-cooked meal is as much of an aphrodisiac as dining out at a fancy restaurant."

The Parship dating service study said women in the Home Counties, Wiltshire and Dorset are the most likely to bag a toyboy.

Those from Glasgow and Yorkshire are the least likely to succeed.
